Fr Michael writes... Already, the world at large is busying itself in preparation for the 'seasonal' festivities ahead, witness the various adverts telling us which supermarket offers the best Christmas dinner; but ours is not the celebration of a 'season', rather it is the celebration of a person, Jesus Christ. This Sunday, the first Sunday of Advent, the Gospel warns us to be alert and stay awake - not for the next best buy, not for Santa, and not, as it happens, for the birth of Christ. No, it calls us to be prepared for Christ's return in power and glory at the end of time. 'You too must stand ready because the Son of man is coming at an hour your do not expect'.

It may be that we are setting our minds to the task of cards and presents. More likely, amidst the current economic challenges, these are things we might be worrying about, but these are not the Lord's concern. On that final day, when he appears in power and glory, he will not be concerned with the cards we did or didn't send, he won't even be asking where his card was, still less will there be a forensic examination of the presents we gave, the decorations we put up, or the dinner that was cooked. No, on the contrary, he will ask a very simple question; what was it that you did with the life and the gifts I gave you. Were you swept up in the world and its concerns, or did you, as Paul reminds us to in today's second reading, heed my word and example, putting me on like armour and allowing me and my ways, not the ways of the world, to be your security and protection.

Synod of Bishops extended Pope Francis has announced that the Synod on Synodality will be extended to 2024. The two sessions of the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops will take place from 4 to 29 October 2023, and in October 2024, bringing together bishops from across the world to discuss and prepare a document to counsel the Pope. Pope Francis explained that he made the decision "in order to have a more relaxed period of discernment."
