Fr Michael writes... This weekend, with the celebration of Christ's entry into Jerusalem, marks the beginning of Holy Week, the most solemn week in the Church's year. In addition to the customary services of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday there will a public celebration of Morning Prayer and the Office of Readings on Thursday, Friday and Saturday at 9.30am. If you are unable attend the principal services why not use the opportunity these present to reflect on the events leading up to Christ's death and resurrection? All are welcome. Finally, please note that there is no 6pm evening Mass next Sunday, Easter Sunday.

Parish Easter Card Market Stall Many thanks to everyone who helped to make the Easter card stall another success. Thanks go to those who collected volunteers' names, accessed the gazebo, shared information with their groups and of course to the brave team who came to hand out invitations to our Easter celebrations. Retiring collections during Holy Week The retiring collection on Maundy Thursday is being held in support of our local SVP. The retiring collection on Good Friday is a special collection for the Holy Places of Palestine. This offering, called for by successive Popes, is used to support our brothers and sisters in the Holy Land.

Easter Offering The priests of the parish do not receive a wage or salary, instead they receive a monthly stipend or allowance which is funded out of the offering received on Easter Sunday and Christmas Day, as well as for masses, baptisms, weddings and funerals. If you wish to use an envelope for this purpose these are available in the porch.

Gift Aid If you are a UK taxpayer and have previously signed a gift aid declaration, but no longer pay tax, please contact the parish office and let us know. If you have stopped paying tax, we cannot claim gift aid on your giving (25p in every pound). If you do not pay tax and gift aid is claimed on what you give, HMRC may seek reimbursement. If you have signed a gift aid form, your offertory or building fund donations need to come from a bank account in your name only or a joint bank account on which you are also named. The 2024/25 tax year ended April 2025 and we will be submitting our gift aid claim for 2024/25 shortly. Please phone or email the parish office with any queries or to notify us of any changes in circumstance in 2024/25.

Stations of the Cross - Good Friday The Stations of the Cross on Good Friday at 6.30pm will be on the theme of the Way of the Cross for Our Time. Following this service, at 7.20pm, the Walk of Witness starts and then processes through the town centre to St Albans Cathedral for the Ecumenical service "Unity at the Cross" which begins at 8pm. You can also view the Stations online and the text will be available to help you reflect upon this prayerful journey through our Lord's passion and death. Children's Way of the Cross takes place on Good Friday at 10.30am.

Easter Garden We are commemorating our deceased loved ones in a special way in our Easter Garden again this year by writing their names on bamboo butterfly shapes and planting them around the rose garden in front of the presbytery. These will be close to the three empty crosses, a symbol of the new life Christ won for us in his resurrection. Mass Intentions Mass intentions can be booked by phoning or visiting the parish office from 9am to 1pm any weekday. Outside of these times, please email the parish office to request a mass intention. Donations can be made by posting an envelope through the presbytery door or by making a payment via bank transfer. Our bank account details can be accessed here. Please note that masses can be booked up to one year in advance and the first masses we now have free for booking are in June/July 2025. Intentions may have to be moved with little notice to accommodate funerals. The suggested diocesan donation, which contributes to the stipends of the priests of our parish, is £10 per mass.

Prayers for the Sick If you would like to include someone in the prayers for the sick, please contact the <u>parish office</u>. Permission from the person being prayed for, or their next of kin, must be obtained before being added to the list. Names will be included for eight weeks, unless the request to have their name included is renewed.
