### Fr Michael writes...

We are blessed in our parish to have a good number of lectors, who read during mass, as well as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, who assist with the distribution of Holy Communion at mass and who take communion home to the sick and housebound. Indeed, it has been really heartening over the last year or so to see a number of younger parishioners coming forward to read.

Each year we have invited our lectors and Eucharistic Ministers to renew their commitment to these ministries and to be recommissioned. Our Lectors or Ministers of the Word will be recommissioned at all Masses this weekend. Its particularly fitting to do this at Pentecost when we are reminded how the Apostles were empowered by the Spirit to proclaim the mighty works of God. Our Ministers of the Eucharist will be recommissioned at all Masses on the Feast of Corpus Christi - the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on Sunday 22 June.

Gift Aid 2024/25 If you are a UK taxpayer and have previously signed a gift aid declaration, but no longer pay tax, please contact the parish office and let us know. If you have stopped paying tax, we cannot claim gift aid on your giving (25p in every pound). If you do not pay tax and gift aid is claimed on what you give, HMRC may seek reimbursement. If you have signed a gift aid form, your offertory or building fund donations need to come from a bank account in your name only or a joint bank account on which you are also named. The 2024/25 tax year ended April 2025 and we will be submitting our gift aid claim for 2024/25 shortly. Please phone or email the parish office with any queries or to notify us of any changes in circumstance in 2024/25.

Intentions may have to be moved with little notice to accommodate funerals. The suggested diocesan donation, which contributes to the stipends of the priests of our parish, is £10 per mass.

Permission from the person being prayed for, or their next of kin, must be obtained before being added to the list. Names will be included for eight weeks, unless the request to have their name included is renewed.
