Fr Michael writes... In the coming month there are a number of retiring collections. Ours is a very generous parish, but I do not wish to take advantage of that generosity. To help you decide which retiring collections you want to support, and to what extent you want to support them, I thought it would be helpful to set out the schedule of forthcoming collections:

1/2 November: You Can Be Santa – in support of the annual initiative to provide for children whose families are not able to celebrate Christmas as all of us would wish to

8/9 November: St Vincent De Paul (SVP) – in support of our parish SVP and their work in support of families and individuals in need in and around St Albans

15/16 November: Sick & Retired Priests Fund – in support of the Diocese's provision for sick and retired priests in the Diocese of Westminster

29/30 November: Friends of the Holy Land – in support of the Christian community in the West Bank, Gaza, Israel and Jordan.

Olive Carvings from the Holy Land The Good Shepherd Company from the Holy Land would like to thank parishioners for their kind support last weekend. Approximately £1,500 was made from the sale of olive carvings in the parish centre.

Fair trade Our fair-trade stall will be open after all Masses this weekend 1/2 November and after Mass at SJF Mass Centre on 9 November. Mass Intentions Mass intentions can be booked by phoning or visiting the parish office from 9am to 1pm any weekday. Outside of these times, please email the parish office to request a mass intention. Donations can be made by posting an envelope through the presbytery door or by making a payment via bank transfer. Our bank account details can be accessed here. Please note that masses can be booked up to one year in advance and the first masses we now have free for booking are in February 2026. Please also be aware that weekday morning masses (excluding Mondays) will be held at St Barts for the duration of the building works. Intentions may have to be moved with little notice to accommodate funerals. The suggested diocesan donation, which contributes to the stipends of the priests of our parish, is £10 per mass.
