Fr Michael writes ... The contractors have continued with their behind the scenes preparation over the last couple of weeks and are due to be on site early this coming week. Please can I remind you:

- that our weekday masses will be held at St Bartholomew's, with the exception of our 10am Monday morning Mass and our evening Masses
- that parking will be more limited than usual
- that you are encouraged to walk to church or park a little further away
- that parking around the church is prioritised for those with limited mobility and with very young families
- that we will be entering and leaving the church via the Parish Centre
- to listen very carefully to the notices before mass when you will be advised of the revised evacuation procedures
- that we will need to rehearse the revised evacuation procedure in the near future
- that both contactless machines are now situated on the way into and out via the Parish Centre

Finally, as the building works actually begin, I would like to thank you all for your patience and to express my ongoing appreciation for your generous support of the building Fund Appeal over the past two years and in the years to come. Without this support we wouldn't be commencing this first phase of development.

Donations can be made by posting an envelope through the presbytery door or by making a payment via bank transfer. Our bank account details can be accessed here. Please note that masses can be booked up to one year in advance and the first masses we now have free for booking are in February 2026. Please also be aware that weekday morning masses (excluding Mondays) will be held at St Barts for the duration of the building works. Intentions may have to be moved with little notice to accommodate funerals. The suggested diocesan donation, which contributes to the stipends of the priests of our parish, is £10 per mass.
