

The Winter Beds Project

As temperatures plummet this winter there are people preparing to bed down and sleep on the streets of St Albans. The cost of living crisis and rising housing have caused more people to sleep rough, with those on the lowest incomes being affected most.

The Open Door Night Shelter offers 12 bed spaces to homeless people in St Albans but there still aren't enough beds.

This winter for the 9th year running The Open Door Charity will be setting up The Winter Beds Project to prevent people from dying on the streets during the coldest months of the year. The Winter Beds Project will provide accommodation for people who are rough sleeping and not accommodated in The Open Door Night Shelter.
