Fr Michael writes... Next week we are due to have the second site meeting with the architects, contractors and quantity surveyor to review progress on the works to the forecourt and church porch. As you will have observed the works to the church forecourt are still in the first stages. In contrast the works on the extended porch are very much in progress with the new kitchen, toilet and storage spaces having been formed and the first fix on the electrics nearing completion. The extended porch really is beginning to take shape and already you can get a sense of its size and potential for gathering, post-mass refreshments and as a meeting space. This last week we have been considering the design of the manifests or transfers to go on the glass doors, ensuring that people will be able to see that there is a glass door in front of them. Also, we are beginning to turn our thoughts to the digital displays / monitors that will be a new feature of the extended porch. These will make the publicity in the fresher, more appealing and better focused – a larger version of what we already have the Parish Centre foyer.

Over the weekend of 20/21 December there will be a practice fire drill to ensure that people are familiar with the revised evacuation procedures. We would like to do this before Christmas because over Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, with larger numbers than usual, it will be important for a crucial mass to know if an evacuation of the building becomes necessary. This coming Christmas, because of the more restricted space in the church, we will stream the busier masses to the hall upstairs and distribute Holy Communion in the hall.

Finally, I would just like to thank you all, from the Sunday congregations, through to the weekday attenders journeying over to St Bartholomew's in the week, for entering into all the changed arrangements with such good spirit.

Intentions may have to be moved with little notice to accommodate funerals. The suggested diocesan donation, which contributes to the stipends of the priests of our parish, is £10 per mass.
