Fr Michael writes...

The ongoing works to the porch have reduced the amount of seating and space available at the back of the church. With Christmas and the large numbers on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, space in the church will be at a premium. To this end, we will be using the main hall as an overflow. Moreover, much as we do for the Family Masses at the end of each month, I am proposing to move the altar up so that it is on the same level as the Tabernacle and to invite the children forward to sit on the carpeted platform during the Christmas Masses. The ambo, from which the scripture readings are proclaimed, will remain where it is, while the priest's chair will be positioned on the carpeted platform. I appreciate that the altar itself may feel further away, but I hope that having a space for the children to come and sit in front of both the altar and the crib will make for a more uplifting and dignified celebration over the Christmas period.

Volunteers Stewards needed for Christmas Masses The Christmas Eve Masses at 5pm & 7pm are usually very busy. We need VOLUNTEER STEWARDS to assist at all of the Masses – welcoming, handing mass books and service sheets, directing people to available seating, showing people to the hall if an overflow is needed, taking up the collection, ushering at the time of communion and, should we need to evacuate the church, pointing people to the nearest available exit. Family Christmas Mass The 5pm Mass on Christmas Eve will be a 'family' Mass and our younger parishioners are welcome to come dressed as Shepherds and Angels.

Parish Christmas Card Thank you to all the children in Years 5 & 6 at St John Fisher School who took part in our annual Illustrating Christmas Competition. The overall winner's entry has been used for this year's Parish Christmas Card now available in the Church. More can be seen on the parish website. The card includes the times of Masses over the Christmas and New Year period as well as the times for confessions. As you will see there are a number of additional times for Confessions in the run up to Christmas. Please make every effort to use one of these scheduled times.

FIRE MARSHALS You may have noticed the appearance of Fire Marshal Instructions on some of the pillars around the church. This is because in order to hold larger services in church we are required to have Fire Marshals and an evacuation procedure in place. Simply put, we have the instructions, but we do not have all the Fire Marshals that we need. Beyond the very occasional training session, all we are asking is that those willing to volunteer as Fire Marshals would act as Fire Marshals in the rare event of our needing to evacuate the building. Christmas is approaching and we will have larger numbers than usual, and the need to have Fire Marshals in place is all the more pressing. If you are willing to volunteer please email the parish office with your name, email address and contact number.

Practice Fire Drill Over the weekend of 20/21 December there will be a practice fire drill to ensure that people are familiar with the revised evacuation procedures. We would like to do this before Christmas because over Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, with larger numbers than usual, it will be important for a crucial mass to know if an evacuation of the building becomes necessary. This coming Christmas, because of the more restricted space in the church, we will stream the busier masses to the hall upstairs and distribute Holy Communion in the hall.

LITURGY AND SACRAMENTS

Sacrament of Baptism The next baptism preparation course is Saturday 7 February 2026 at 11.30am. To register or to arrange a date for baptism please speak to Fr Michael or Fr John after any of the weekend masses.

Monthly 10am Family Mass on the last Sunday of the month. There is no Children's Liturgy on the last Sunday of each month. Instead, children are invited to sit on the carpet at the front of the church and the Mass itself is geared towards their participation. There is then a short social for everyone after mass.

OUR PARISH COMMUNITY

Christmas Day Dinners Christmas at St Alban & St Stephen is quite something with a wonderful array of activities and initiatives for young and old in addition to the Christmas Masses. The Christmas Day dinner is one of these. It used to be served in the hall, but has been delivered directly to people at home for the last 5 years. This year, because of the building works and reduced capacity in the Church, we will be streaming Masses to the hall upstairs. This will put the hall kitchen out of use. This being so, and particularly conscious of the 'Tinsel and Turkey Lunch' offered in early January, I am proposing that we do not offer Christmas Dinner on Christmas Day. I appreciate that this will be a disappointment, but with the running and busyness of two parishes at Christmas, as well as the pressure placed on the Parish Centre by the current building works, I think stepping back from the Christmas Day Dinner for this year is the most realistic thing to do. If anyone has a particular concern as a result of this please do come back to me.

Monday Office Volunteers We currently have a group of five volunteers who come into the presbytery on Monday mornings between 9am and 1pm on a rota basis to answer the door and phone, and to undertake some light office duties. the SVP, the Life House and individual parishioners. We are also supporting children from the St Albans Refuge, Home Start and the Intensive Family Support Team. In addition, several adults with either special needs or living in a refuge will also receive a Christmas voucher. Thank you once again, your donations really make a huge difference to so many children within our community at this time of year.

Migrants' toiletries and clothing collections We currently need donations of sanitary towels (not tampons), shower gel, toothpaste, shampoo, baby wipes, adult toothbrushes, deodorant, bars of soap, baby shower gel and shampoo. Donations of men's clothing are also needed for local migrants. Please only donate items which you would be happy to give to a family member or friend. While the building works are taking place, there will be a collecting point for these items on the third Sunday of each month.

St Albans Food Bank We currently have a food collection point at all masses, including the Marshalswick Mass centre on the first Sunday of each month. The principal demand remains for long life milk, long life juice and tinned fruit. More details of the St Albans Food bank can be found here.

Mass Intentions Mass intentions can be booked by phoning or visiting the parish office from 9am to 1pm any weekday. Outside of these times, please email the parish office to request a mass intention. Donations can be made by posting an envelope through the presbytery door or by making a payment via bank transfer. Our bank account details can be accessed here. Please note that masses can be booked up to one year in advance and the first masses we now have free for booking are in March / April 2026. Please also be aware that weekday morning masses (excluding Mondays) will be held at St Barts for the duration of the building works. Intentions may have to be moved with little notice to accommodate funerals. The suggested diocesan donation, which contributes to the stipends of the priests of our parish, is £10 per mass.
